Super Valu Incorporated Award

After discussion, the Board came to an agreement on the rules for competing for the Super Valu Incorporated, Bismarck Division Award.

To be eligible for the award, you must be a current NDQHA member who is also a North Dakota resident. All points must be earned at North Dakota approved shows.

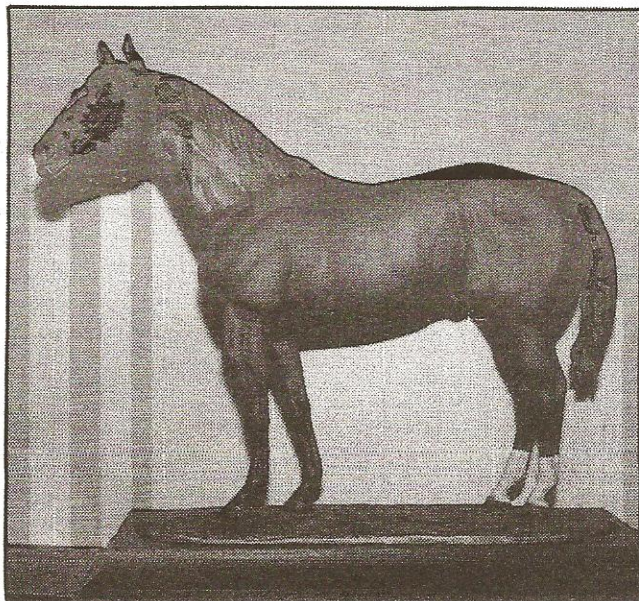
To qualify for the Super Valu Incorporated Award, a horse must earn a minimum of 35 AQHA points. The horse must receive at least 10 halter points with 7 points earned after the horse is 2 years of age. The performance points earned shall be a minimum of 10 points in one category and 15 in any or all other categories. The first horse to accumulate the necessary points will win the award.

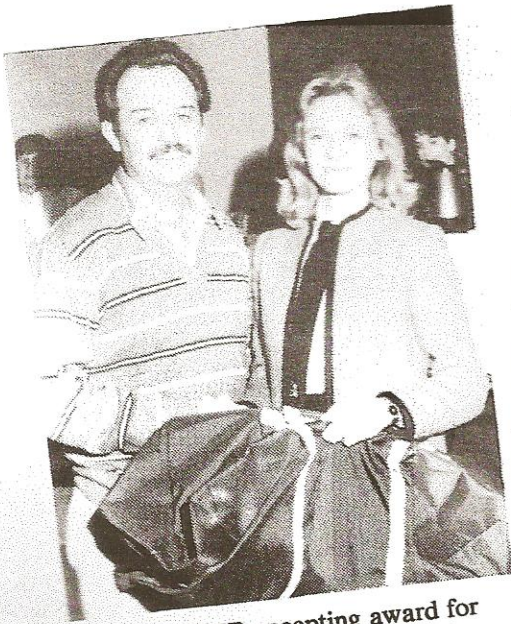
The contest shall run from January 1, 1987 to December 31, 1989. If necessary points have not been accumulated by December 31, 1989, the award will be presented to the horse which comes closest to the qualifications. The decision of the Board of Directors will be final.

It shall be the owners responsibility to furnish an AQHA printout before the award is received.

The Super Valu Incorporated Award will be presented at the Annual Meeting in the year the award is won.

This motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously by the Board.

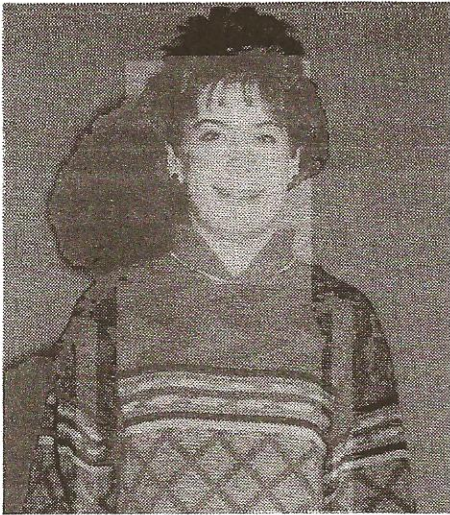
